WHY RPL in Austria ...?



- At European level COUNCIL RECOMMENDATION of 20 December 2012 on the validation of non-formal and informal learning 2012/C 398/01
- At national level in Austria
 - 2011: Austrian Lifelong Learning Strategy "LLL:2020": '...acquired skills and competences, regardless of where they were acquired, be recognised and certified, thus placing non-formal and informal education processes on an equal level with formal education processes.'
 - 2017: National strategy on the social dimension of higher education.
 Refers to LLL:2020 strategy
 - Very strong social selection on access to HE and low numbers of people with academic degrees
 - Very strong vocational education sector -> highly qualified people who might strive for academic qualification

WHY was it difficult to get started?



- Different legal provisions in Austria for different sectors, eg:
 - No RPL of non-formal and informal learning at public universities
 - RPL at Universities of Applied Sciences /Fachhochschulen (since 1994)
- Little experience with RPL, little knowledge on procedures
- Little/no trust in RPL
- AQ Austria was commissioned by the Ministry to start the RPL process in Austria and to support and promote the implementation process

WHY AQ Austria....?



- AQ Austria works cross sectoral (public & private universities, UAS/Fachhochschulen, teacher training colleges,...)
- As an QA Agency our focus is on quality assured processes
- RPL as criterion within the accreditation procedure
- Biggest challenge: to build trust in quality of RPL and its procedures

WHY did we do it the way we did?



- Project groups with HEIs (starting in 2015, open end...) in order to develop applicable recommendations for RPL procedures together
- ... and with experts in the field of RPL from experienced EU countries (FIN, Germany, Ireland,...) in order to learn from their experiences
- Close contact to the Ministry in order to move the legal basis for RPL forward
- Support provided by the Ministry in order to motivate HEIs to implement RPL
- Permanent activities by AQ Austria in order to support HEIs and promote the implementation of RPL



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WHY do Austrian HEIs implement RPL?
