EUROPASS DIPLOMA SUPPLEMENT

The Diploma Supplement model was developed by the European Commission, Council of Europe and UNESCO/CEPES. The purpose of the supplement is to provide sufficient independent data to improve the professional, temporary and for academic and professional recognition of qualifications (diplomas, degrees, certificates etc.). It is designed to provide a description of the nature, level, content, context and status of the studies that were followed and successfully completed by the individual named on the original qualification to which the supplement is appended. It should be free from any value judgements, equivalence statements or suggestions about recognition. Information in all eight sections should be provided. Where information is not provided, an explanation should give the reason why.

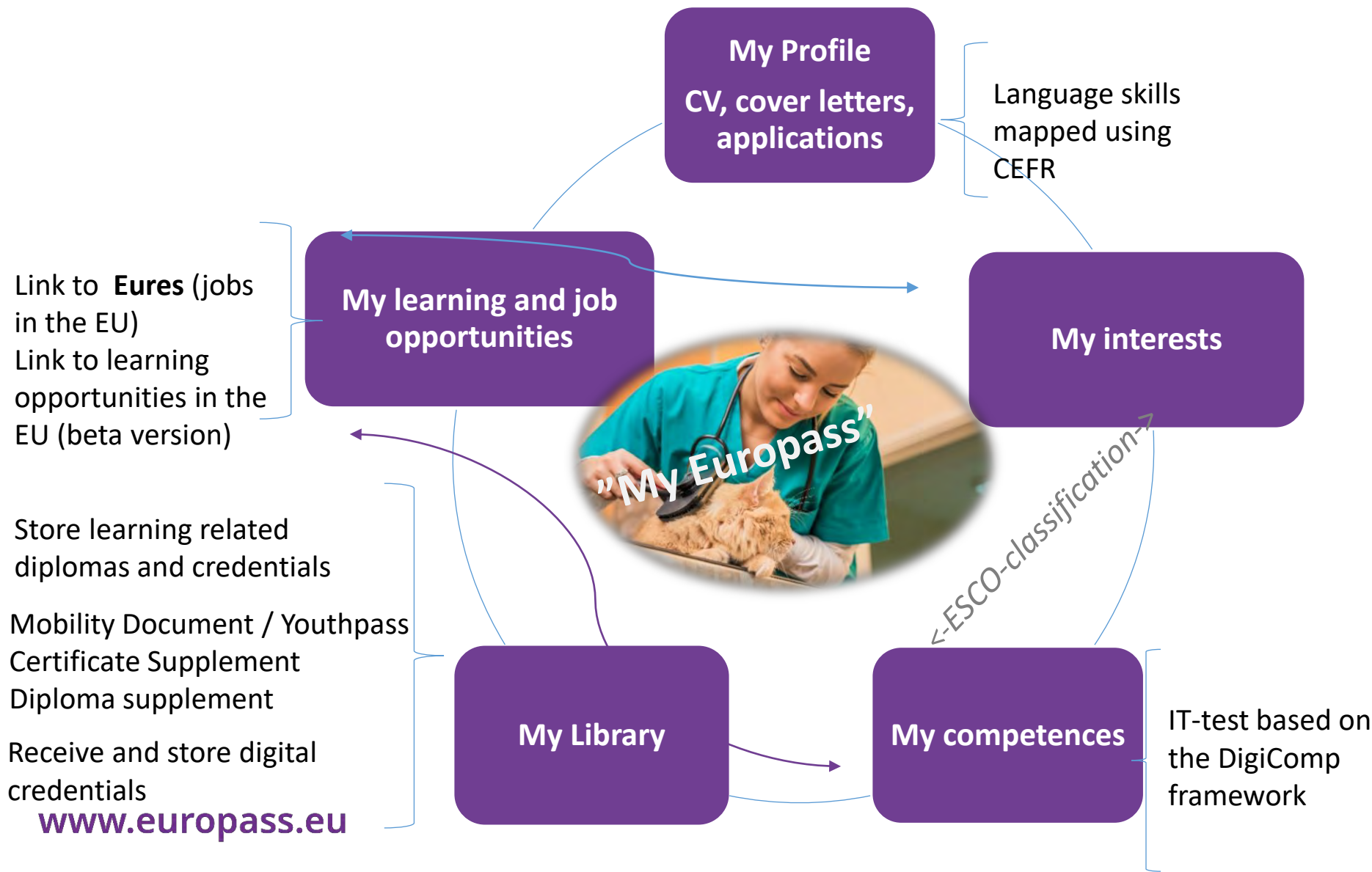



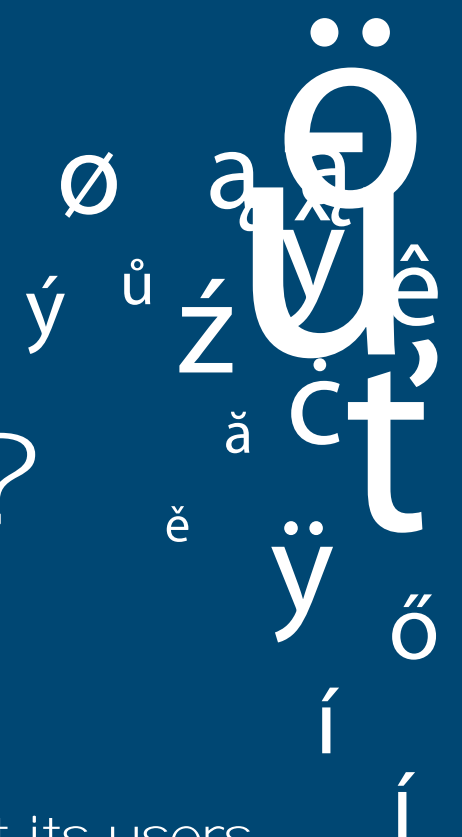

Why a course on Europass?



- Euroguidance Network aims to support guidance practitioners.
- Europass is a free set of online tools and information to support its users in their lifelong learning and career management.
- It was only logical that Euroguidance should offer a course to promote Europass and improve the skills of guidance professionals across Europe.



What topics are covered?

The course aims to provide basic training on Europass platform and tools

- **Introduction to Europass:** Europass to present your skills and qualifications; Searching for employment or education opportunities in Europe
- **Europass portal:** Profile, CV and Cover Letter
- **Other Europass functionalities:** Europass Library, Digital Skills Test, Applications Manager, My Skills, My Interests...
- **How to use Europass with your clients:** Practical work with applicants, pupils, students, employers...

What will you achieve?

By the end of the course, you'll be able to...

- recognize the purposes for which the Europass tool can be used
- identify the parts of the Europass tools and the functions they are used for
- create your personal Europass profile, CV and cover letter, identify potential learning and/or work opportunities
- advise different client groups on the relevant Europass tools for their needs
- support clients in developing their own personal Europass profile, CV and cover letter, as needed





Who is the course for?

- This course is designed for guidance counsellors in different settings: primary and secondary schools, VET, higher education, employment etc., wanting to enhance their guidance skills and understand ways to use Europass as a tool for guidance
- It is also suitable for other members of school communities including teachers, youth educators etc. who work with users who need to identify their competences, present them in a transparent way and apply for jobs or find suitable learning opportunities throughout Europe

Thanks to its diverse audience and the dynamic environment of career guidance, potential actions that can be developed are almost endless.

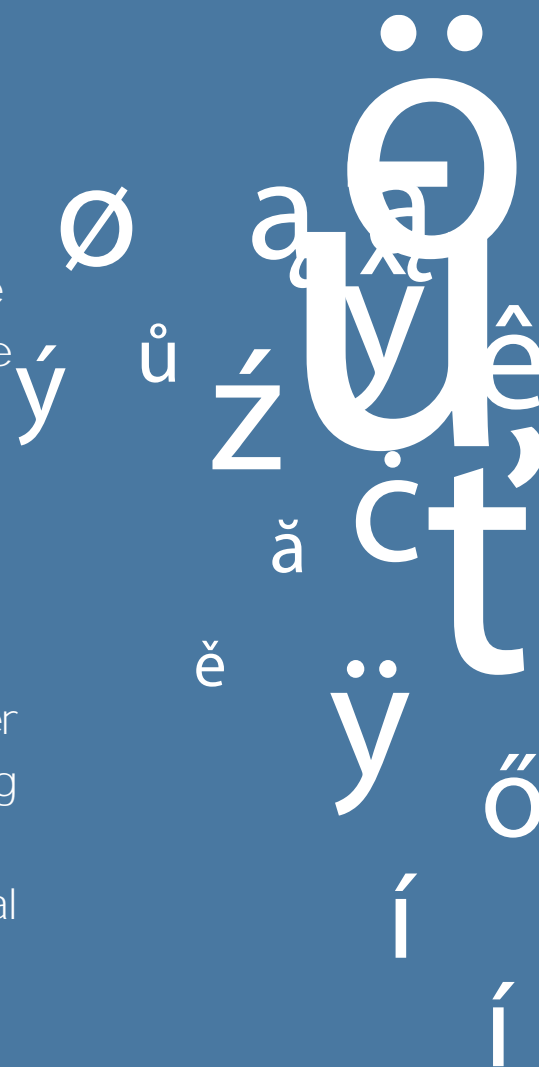


EUROPASS IN CROATIA

Free set of online tools used to create trusted, attractive and recognisable presentations **of users'** skills, experiences and achievements to potential employers or education institutions across Europe.

Widely used for its CV and Cover Letter editor, but recently it is becoming increasingly known for its:

- E-portfolio, Library and Digital Credentials
- Two-factor authentication
- Europass Mobility, Certificate and Diploma Supplements, etc.
